1. **Call to Order** Chair Jillian Vinci called the meeting to order at 6:02 pm with roll call to establish a quorum.

Loosely, the new path forward will be less about “celebrations” and more focused on understanding the makeup of Colchester’s people and how we support and integrate that diversity.
