- 2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
- 3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve minutes from 3/27 Regular Meeting, 4/3 Public Hearing #1, 4/15 Budget Workshop #1, 4/24 Budget Workshop #2 made by M. Egan 2nd by M. Hayes. Motion carried 6-0.

 - a. FY22/23 Transfer from FS, HR, and Planning to Legal & Insurances
 Motion to approve the consolidation of FY 22/23 legal budget line item in the FS office \$30K, HR \$15k and
 P&Z/Code Enforcement \$10k to legal & insurances for total of \$55k. Made by K. Belding 2nd by M. Egan.
 Motion carried 6-0.
 - b. FY23/24 Transfer from FS, HR, and Planning to Legal & Insurances

 Motion for BOF to approve the consolidation of FY 23/24 legal budget line items in FS office \$38.5k, HR

 \$20k and P&Z/Code Enforcement \$10k to legal & insurances for total of \$68.5k. Made by K. Belding 2nd by

 - c. FY22/23 Transfer Unexpended Bond Principal to Deby Service Fund
 Motion for BOF to transfer FY 22/23 unexpended bond principal budget of \$225k to the debt service fund
 for future debt service payments. Made by K. Belding 2nd by M. Hayes. Motion carried 6-0.



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d. FY23/24 Transfer Unexpended Bond Principal and Interest to Debt Service Fund

Motion for BOF to transfer FY 23/24 unexpended bond principle of \$225k and unexpended bond interest of \$11k to debt service fund for total of \$236k. Made by K. Belding 2nd by M. Hayes. Motion carried 6-0.

9. TOWN BUDGET

a. Review and Motion to Approve Revenue for Town/Schools

Motion for FY 24/25 proposed budget to raise the ambulance revenue line item by \$20k from the amount of \$580k to new total of \$600k. Made by K. Belding. 2nd by M. Hayes. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion to accept the collection rate as stated in the budget and as indicated by our Tax Collector of 98.8% for FY 24/25 budget. Made by M. Egan 2nd by K. Belding Motion carried 6-0.

Motion that the board approves FY 24/25 proposed budget revenue values as stated in the budget book with the one revision of the line item for ambulance revenue as prior motioned. Will bring total new revenue to \$ 17,135,173. Made by K. Belding 2nd by M. Hayes. *Motion rescinded by K. Belding*.

Motion to approve the proposed budget book revenue numbers with the addition of the prior motioned ambulance revenue update of \$20k. Motion rescinded by K. Belding
